On 06/04/2020, a group photo giving a motivational message was taken and compiled by NSS volunteers from their respective homes.







<u>Program-4 NSS Online meeting of volunteers</u> (13/04/2020)

<u>Program-6 Tree Plantation Programme</u> (23/06/2020)





Program-12 National Girl Child Day and POCSOAct-2012 Awareness Webinar (23/01/2021)




