

Date: 15/08/2023 Number of Participants: 250


Place: Government Science College, Gandhinagar.


# **Activity :- 22 Voting Oath**

Recognized as Martyrs' Day in India, this date commemorates the 92nd death anniversary of the brave martyrs Veer Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev Thapar, and Shivram Rajguru. Their indelible contributions to India's independence movement are revered nationwide, and the entire country pays homage to them on this day, aptly known as 'Shaheed Diwas' or 'Martyrs Day'.



From February 11<sup>th</sup> to February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024, the NSS unit of Government Science College, Gandhinagar, organized a seven-day special NSS camp in Por village of Gandhinagar district as part of the "Viksit Bharat@2047" initiative. 


