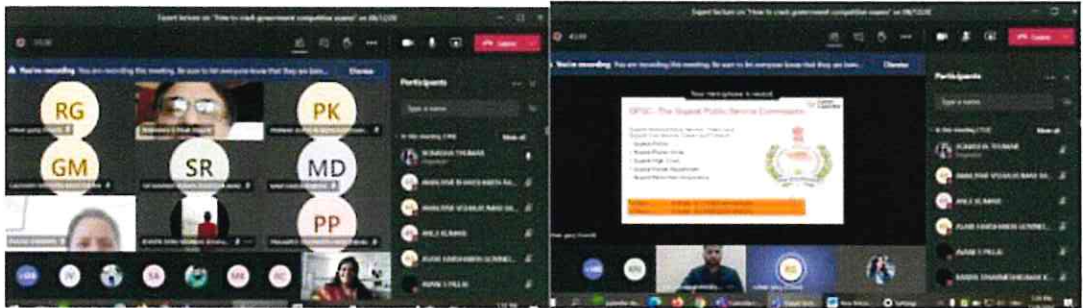


Webinar on “How to crack Government competitive exams”

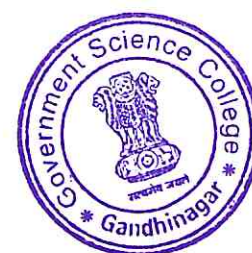

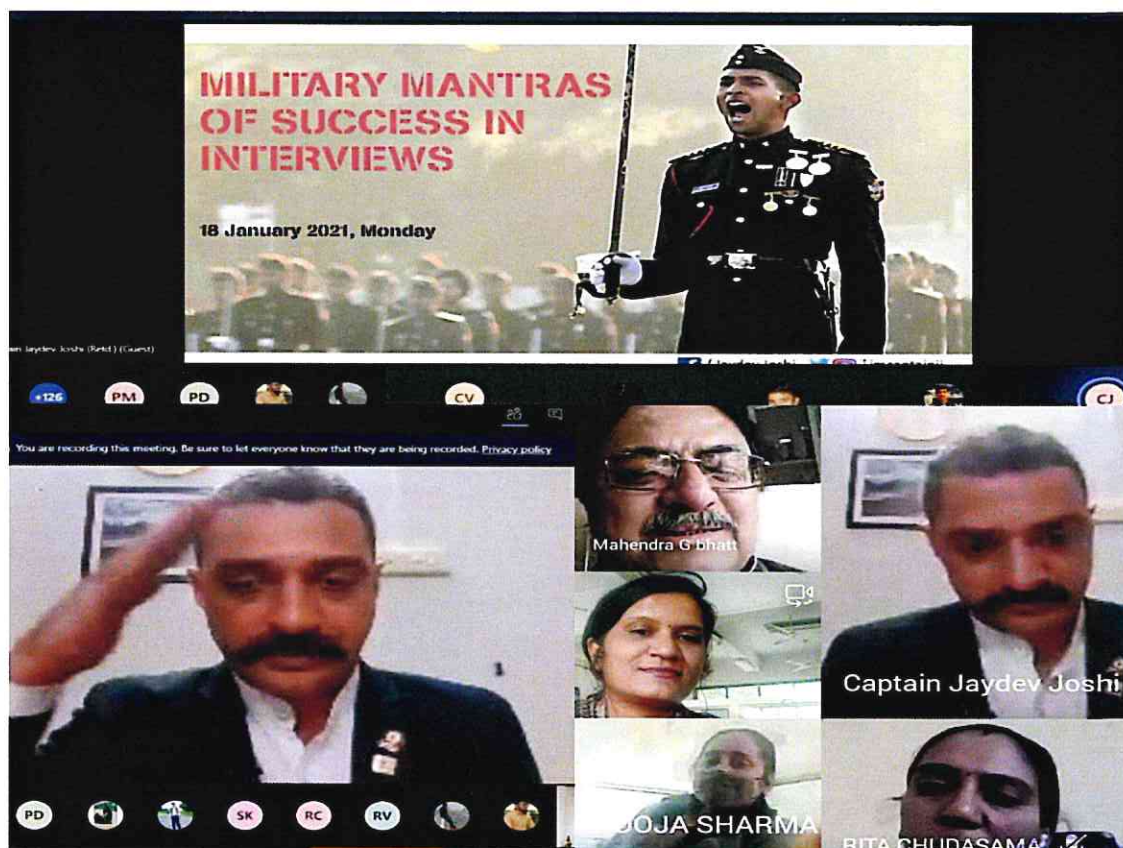


18 January, 2021

Seminar-1: “Military Mantra of Succeeding in Interviews”

In his inaugural address, retired Captain Jaydev Joshi (Indian Army) briefed the students on every aspect of the interview through various examples as per military discipline. He provided information on following area.

1. Be on Time
2. Think Before You Speak
3. Speak Clearly, Cohesively, and Calmly
4. Be Confident, Not Arrogant
5. Express Optimism, Both With Your Words and Your Body Language
6. Show Interest, Without Desperation
7. Know More Than Your Elevator Pitch
8. Express Gratitude

Seminar-2: “The Power of Positive Attitude”

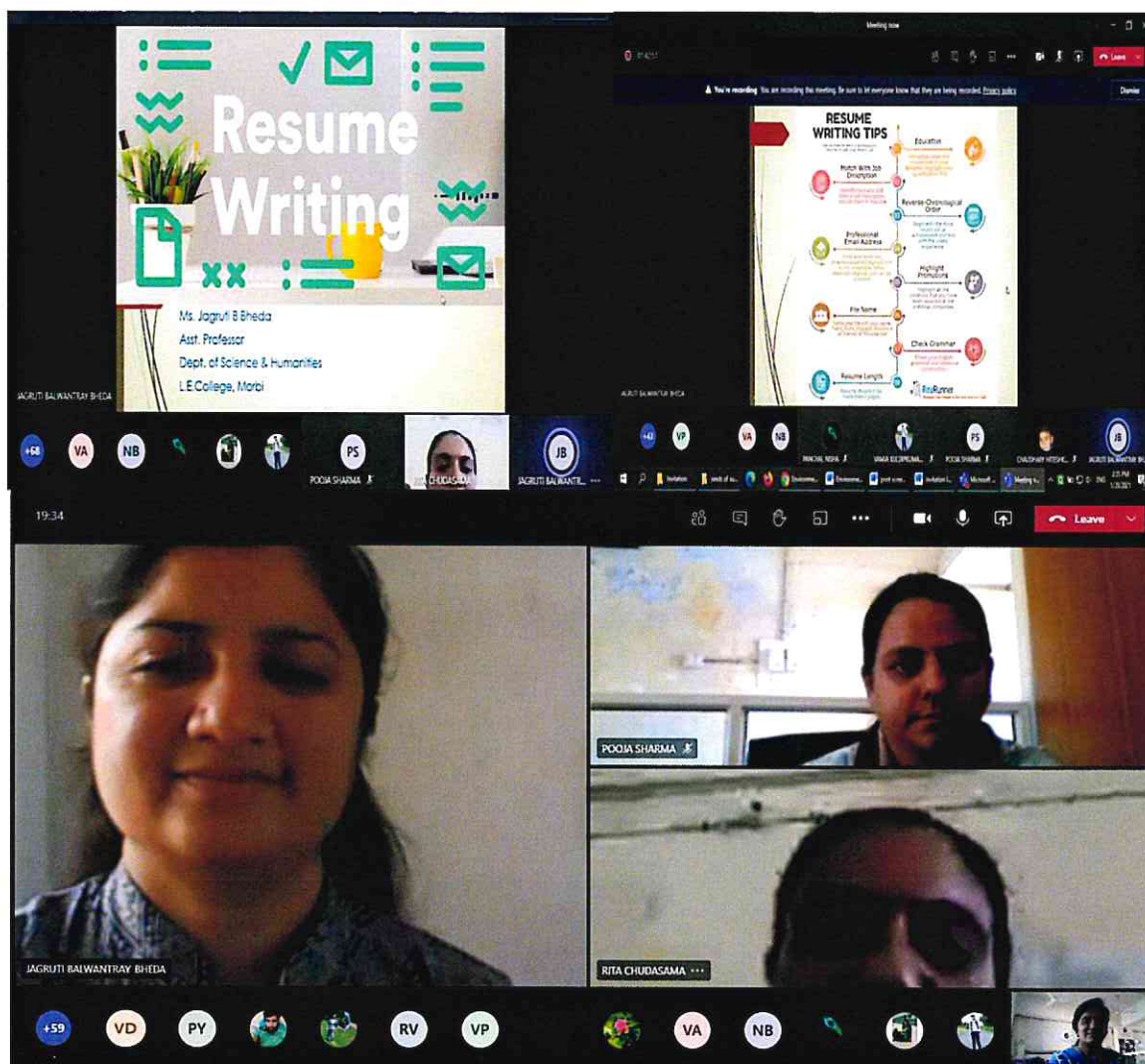
On 19 January, 2021 **Dr. Mehul Dave**, Associate Professor, IITE, **Gandhinagar** delivered a motivational lecture on “The power of positive attitude”. Dr. Dave included a range of examples in his talk to explain how positive attitude helps in building career. Developing positive attitude at work can determine how successful you are in your career. Choose or create a positive mental attitude trigger phrase and repeat it aloud many times each day. A habit trigger is an event, action, or thought that helps to reinforce your positive habits.



20 January, 2021

Seminar-3: “Resume Writing”

Dr. Jagruti Bheda, Asst. professor, LE college, Morbi highlighted the role of resume for any job seeker. She further explained different types of resumes and stated that there are three standard resume formats: chronological, functional, and hybrid (sometimes called a combination resume). For most job seekers, a hybrid resume format, which puts equal emphasis on skills and work experience, is the best choice. However, in some cases, a chronological or functional resume might work better as suggested by her. She also shared various formats of the resume with students.



21 January, 2021

Seminar-4: “Non-verbal communication”

Dr. Richa Sharma, Head-department of humanities delivered a talk on ‘non-verbal communication’ and explained that Nonverbal communication is the process of sending and receiving messages without using words, either spoken or written. She further emphasised that Nonverbal communication is an essential aspect of the interview preparation, and in many cases, it becomes the deciding factor of whether or not you will excel in the interview. From the clarity in your voice, to how you dress, everything affects your chances of getting the job, making nonverbal communication skills a significant hiring factor. Students actively participated in question-answer sessions.

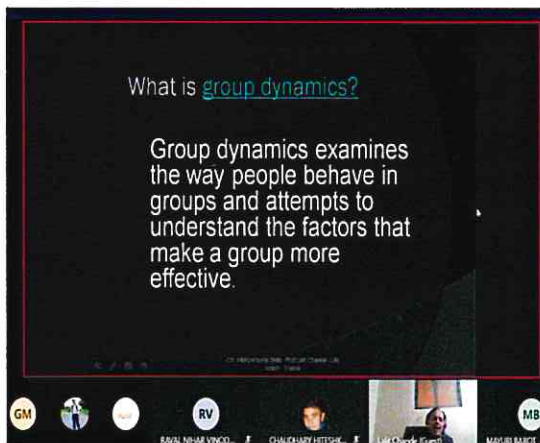

On 22 January, 2021, Prof. Lalit Chande explained in detail that Interpersonal skills are the skills we use every day when we communicate and interact with other people, both individually and in groups. They include a wide range of skills, but particularly communication skills such as listening and effective speaking. He further emphasised that emotional intelligence, team working, conflict resolution and influencing skills etc. are inevitable parts of interpersonal skills. During the session, students asked a lot of questions on how to improve the same for personality development and also for job interviews.

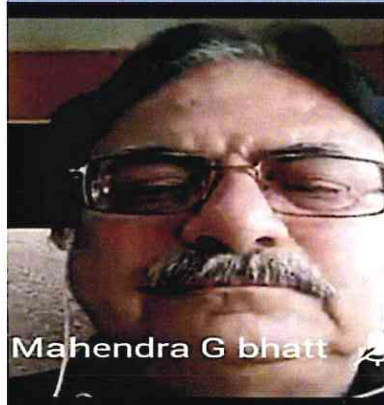
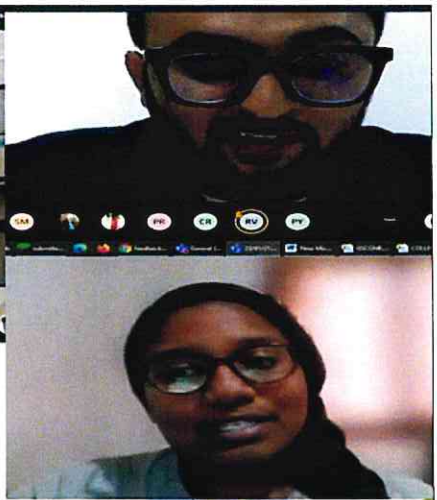
Seminar-6: “Interview Skills”

He gave demonstration by taking interview of the students during his session and tried to answer the doubts as maximum as possible. 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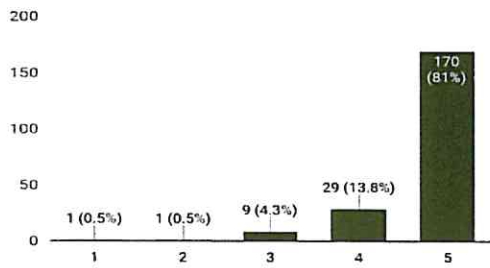


Student's Feedback on "The Seeds of Success"

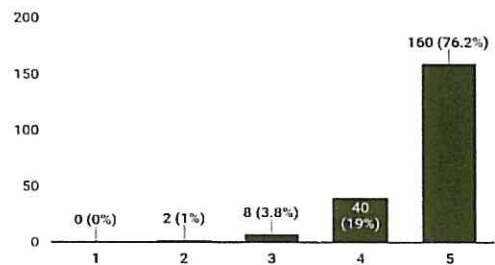
1. How would you rate the theme of the online seminar series?

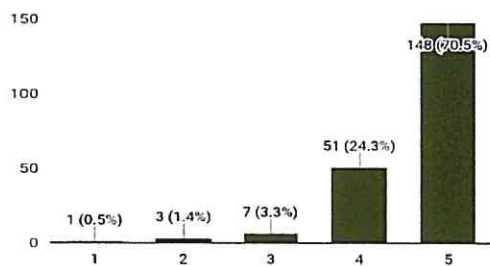
2. How much useful and interesting was the content of the topics?

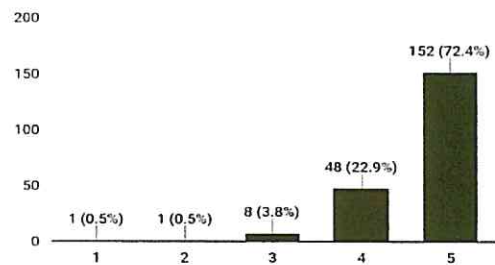
3. How do you rate the overall learning experience of the seminar?

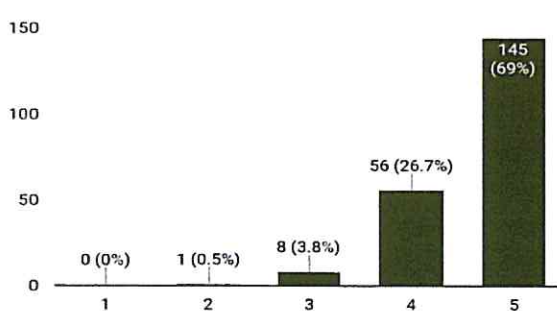
4. Was the quality of the content consistent throughout the event?

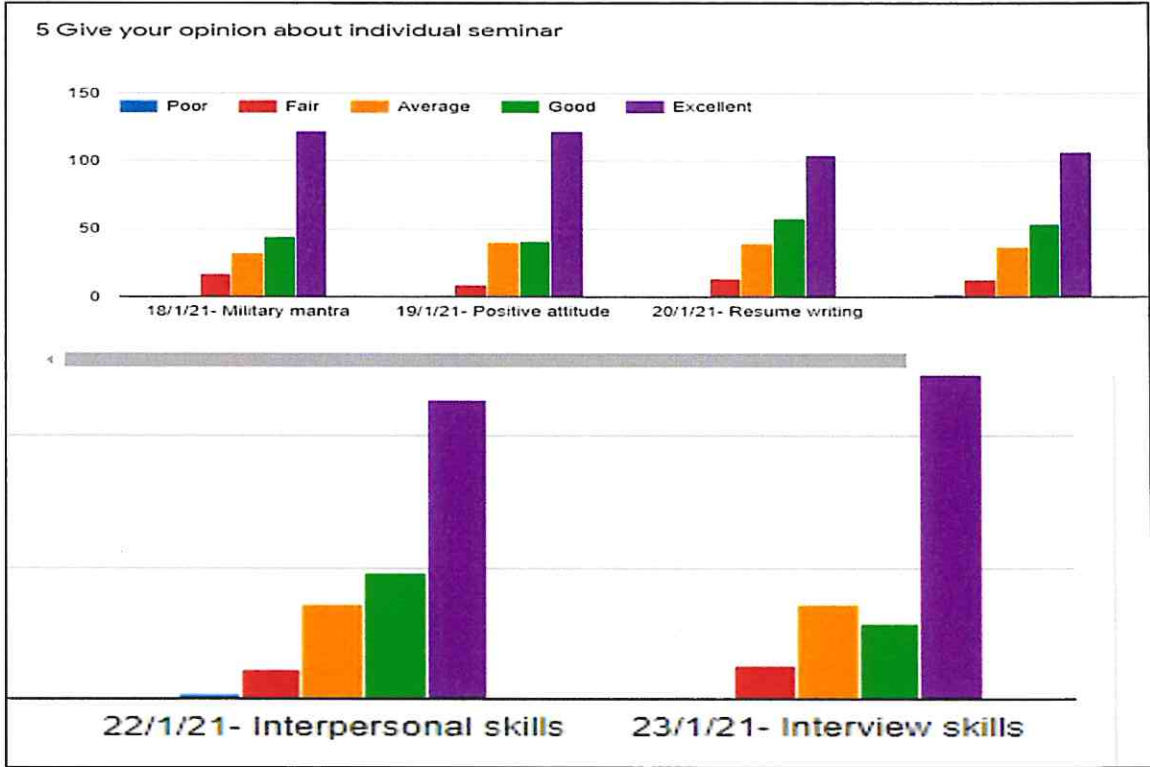

Dr. Deep kumar Trivedi, Associate Professor, IITE, Gandhinagar was invited to train the students for English not only as a basic language, but also as the professional language of communication in job interviews. Dr. Trivedi took more than 6 hours sessions to develop English proficiency among the students of final year B.Sc. and M.Sc. **Principal, Dr. M. G. Bhatt**, in the inaugural lecture emphasized that English is immensely important wherever you are in the world. In countries where English is not a native or official language, over two-thirds of employers say that English is important for their business. English is the language of international business. The survey shows that English language skills are important for over 95% of employers in many non-native English-speaking countries. So the importance of English for the interview has to be understood. By saying this, Dr. Bhatt motivated students to attend the sessions with consistency and interest. More than 250 students were benefited by this lecture series.

Dr. Trivedi suggested various mobile applications and a few basic books to improve the grammar. In addition, he explained that interactive content on Youtube can also be important for good communication.. Reading in English is essential for maintaining professional knowledge, as it is the language most often used in international journals, contracts, and instructions.



Online seminar on: Opportunities for Microbiologists in Pharma Sector

To guide the final year B.Sc. Microbiology students for the future opportunities in pharma industries, we invited **Mr. Jaydev Bhatt- Executive Officer, production department, Zydus Biologics, Ahmedabad** (also an alumnus of Microbiology department) on online platform to interact with the students. **Principal- Dr. M. 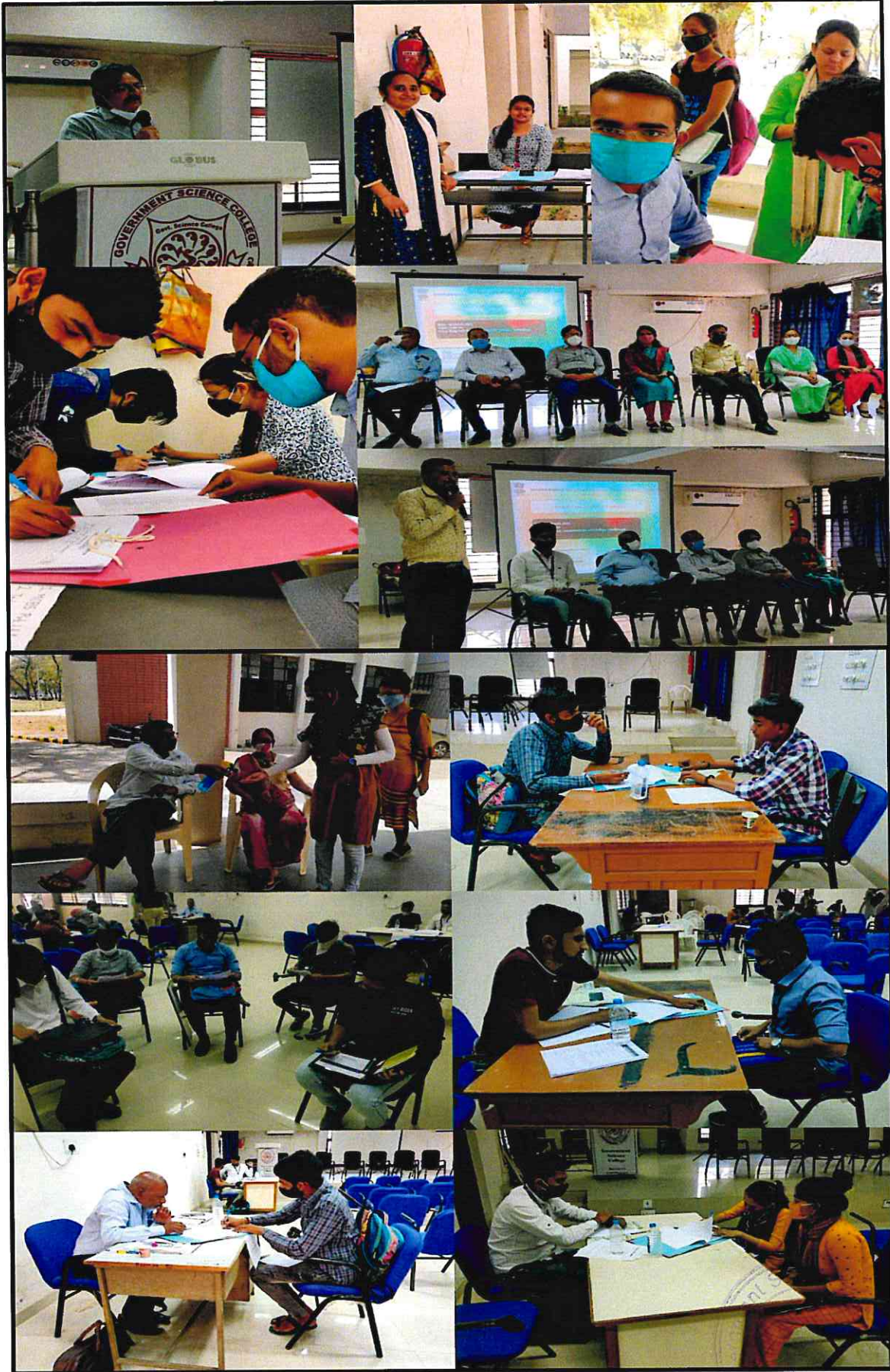

Campus Placement Drive was organized on 08/03/2021. Under the mentorship of Principal **Dr. M. G. Bhatt** and co-operation of DEE office, **Mr. Satish Patel, Ms. Sona Parmar and Mrs. Gami**, the UDISHA Committee of the college successfully coordinated the event; planning and Execution by **Dr. Jignasha Thumar**, coordination with students by **Prof. Vivek Dave**, Registration of students by **Dr. Pooja Sharma** and anchoring of the inaugural programme by **Dr. Mayuri Barot**. Hon'ble Principal Secretary, Department of Education, Government of Gujarat and Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat, GOG has been organising mega placement fair since the academic year 2018-19 for the purpose of providing employment opportunities to all the students studying in the final year of the college. TRAINING & PLACEMENT CELL (T&P CELL) of KCG and Department of Higher education, Government of Gujarat coordinates the placement activities in every district of Gujarat state.

Data of all the students studying in the final year at Government Science College, Gandhinagar College was submitted to KCG for registration during December, 2020. A total of 450 students (B.Sc. and M.Sc.) were registered. In addition, 10 Industries were also registered for the Placement Fair by Government Science College for the placement camp. The registered entries, student consent, student choice filling and student shortlisting process by industries on very impressively designed Placement portal was regularly monitored and followed up by the members of UDISHA committee of the college under the guidance of Hon. Principal Dr. M. G. Bhatt.

Because of COVID- 19 pandemic, for the year of 2020-21, the placement camp was organised in ONLINE mode at Government Arts College, Gandhinagar- the Nodal college of Gandhinagar district. The students of Government Science College, Gandhinagar gave interviews to about 12 companies. Out of the total 450 registered students, 394 students were primary selected and were offered attractive job offers by reputed companies. Because many students were offered more than one job, the actual number of selected students (after removing duplicate entries) was 221 out of 280 students appeared for online interviews.

The chairman of UDISHA committee Dr. Jignasha Thumar worked as the coordinator from the institute during the online interview process, as and when asked by Nodal College, including updating the students about the interview schedules, sending the list of interested students to the companies and also remained present in almost every online selection processes followed by getting the letters of intent from assigned companies.


