Modes of Evaluation:

1. **Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE): - Formative**

- CCE will be undertaken by the concerned faculty member. The mode of evaluation will be decided by the faculty member concerned with the subject. CCE consists of class participation, case analysis and presentation, assignment, tutorials, group discussion, attendance, etc or any combination of these.
- After completion of the syllabus, the faculty member will conduct mid-term evaluation. A wide range of modes of evaluation for evaluating students is available for the teachers to use. The mode of mid-term evaluation will be decided by the faculty member concerned with the subject.

The concerned faculty member can decide any one or two modes from the following:
