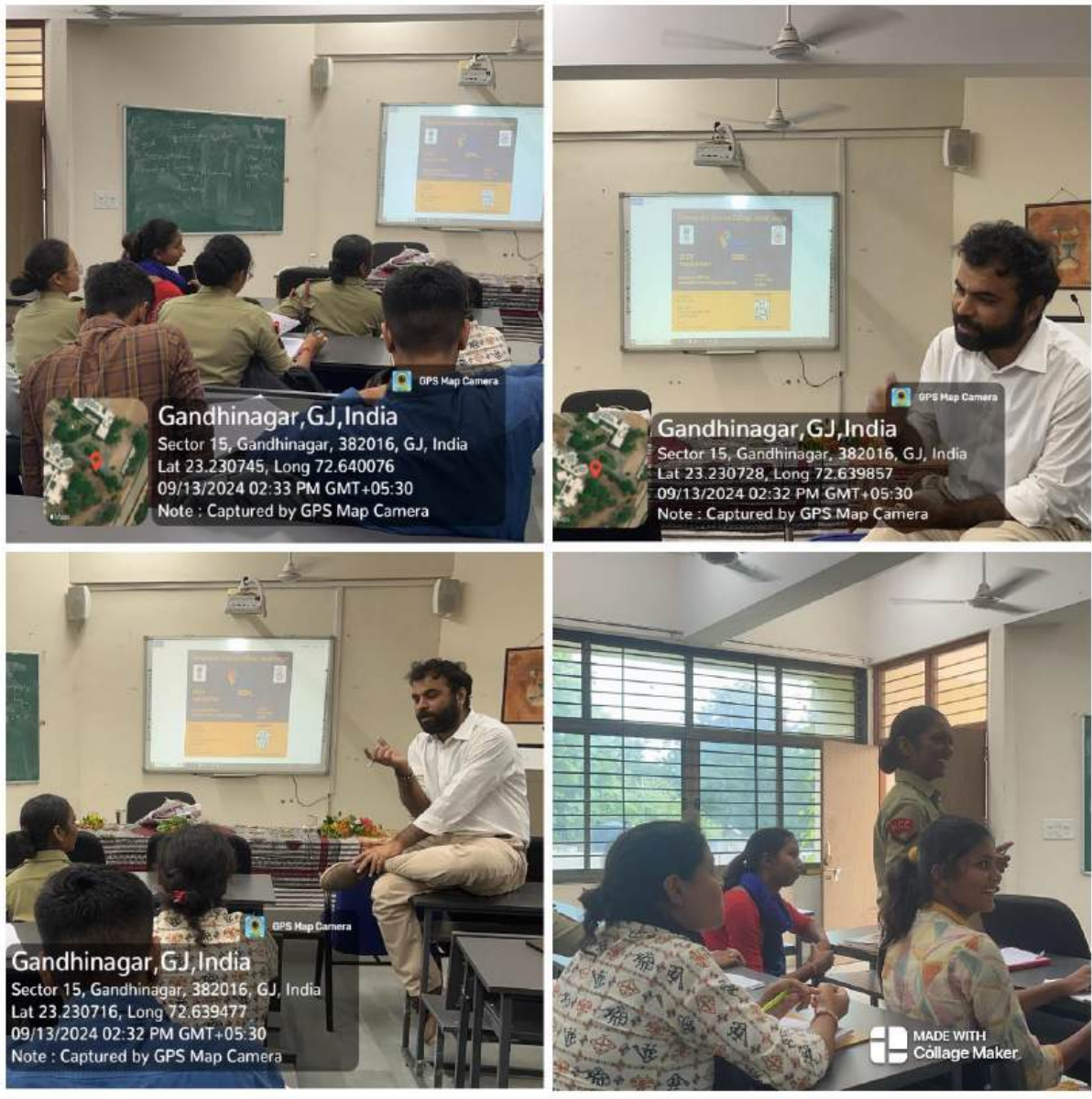


Inauguration Ceremony


Sessions and Key Highlights

Interactive Session and Q&A


