Procedures and Policies for maintaining and utilizing Physical Infrastructure, Laboratory, Classrooms, Library and Sports Facilities.

The institution has established comprehensive procedures for the maintenance and utilization of its physical infrastructure. The Institution Development Committee ensures adequate allocation and utilization of available UGC grants and funds for maintenance. This committee operates as follows:

- Initially, the Committee collects suggestions for infrastructure maintenance from various sources, which are then analysed by the Infrastructure Committee.
- Following analysis, the institution informs the relevant authorities for repair work. For new infrastructure projects, proposals are submitted to various funding agencies such as the Commissionerate of Higher Education, Gujarat, Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat (KCG, Ahmedabad), and the University Grants Commission, Delhi.
- Additional financial expenses, including electricity bills, telephone bills, municipality taxes, and other academic expenses, are covered by funds allocated by the Government of Gujarat.
- Campus security, cleanliness, and maintenance of facilities such as classrooms and laboratories are managed by class-4 staff, with maintenance sometimes outsourced to agencies funded by KCG.
- Annual maintenance contracts are in place for computers, while ICT-enabled Smart Classrooms and related systems are maintained by outsourcing agencies.
- As a fully Government institution, any infrastructural maintenance requires notification to the R&B Department of the Government of Gujarat, which provides funds for such maintenance.
- Academic support facilities, including libraries, laboratories, museums, botanical
 gardens, gymnasiums, institutional sports facilities, and community halls, are
 accessible not only to institution students but also to students from sister government
 colleges in surrounding areas. Gymnasiums, playgrounds, and community halls are
 available to stakeholders with prior permission from the authorities.
- A budget provision is made by the institutional committee for library maintenance, with activities such as fumigation and cleaning conducted regularly.
