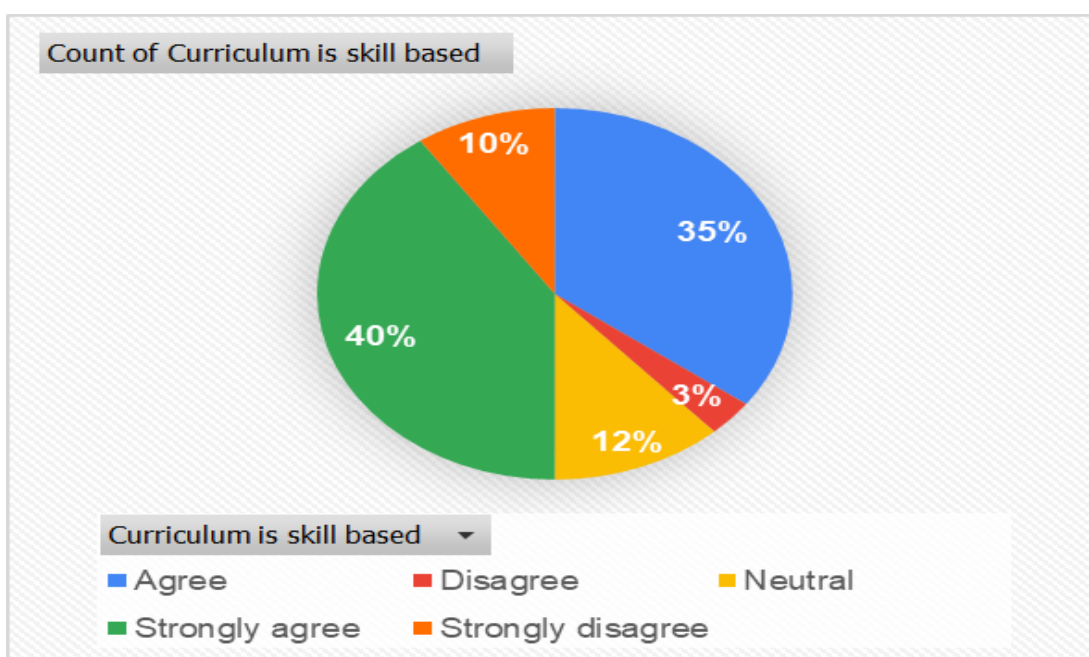

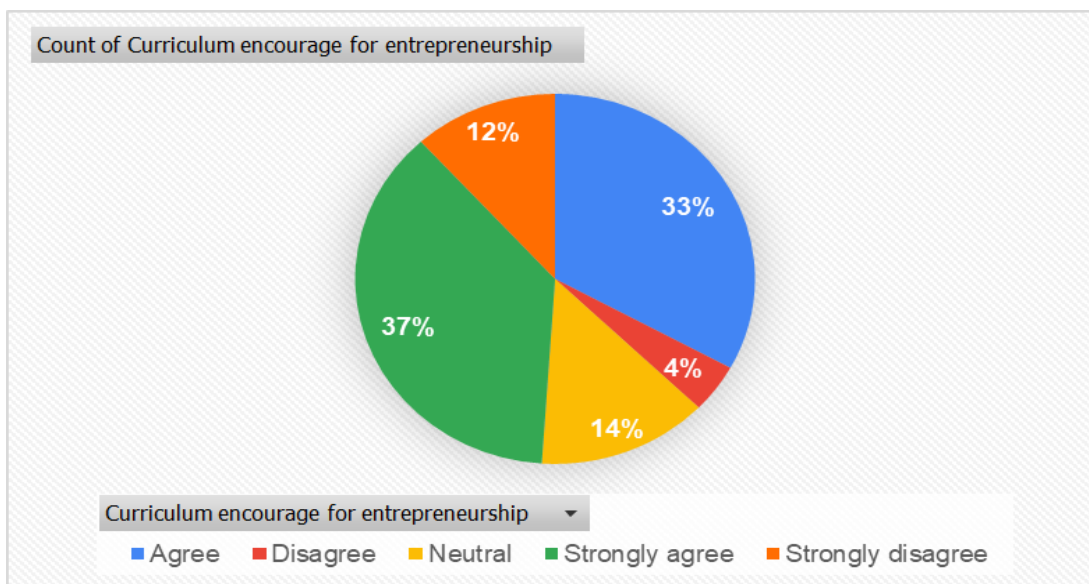

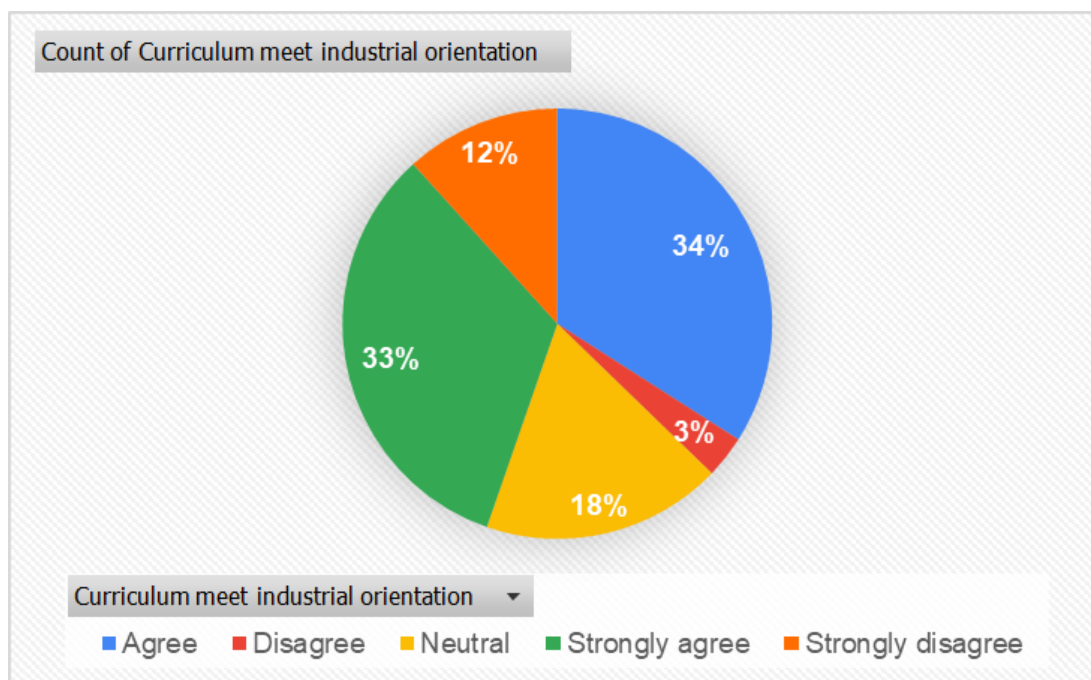

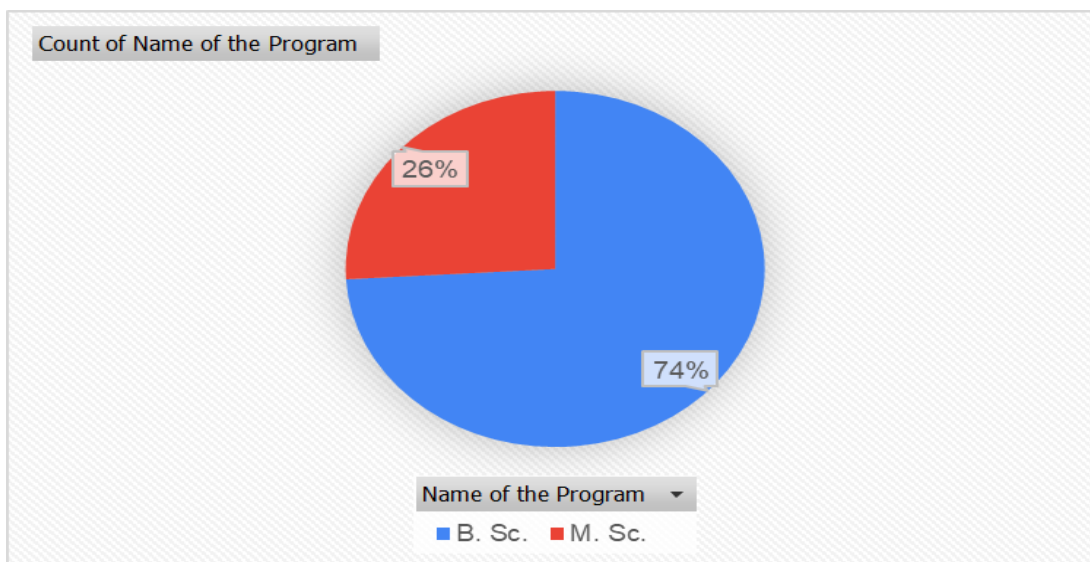
Few of the suggestions received are as follows:

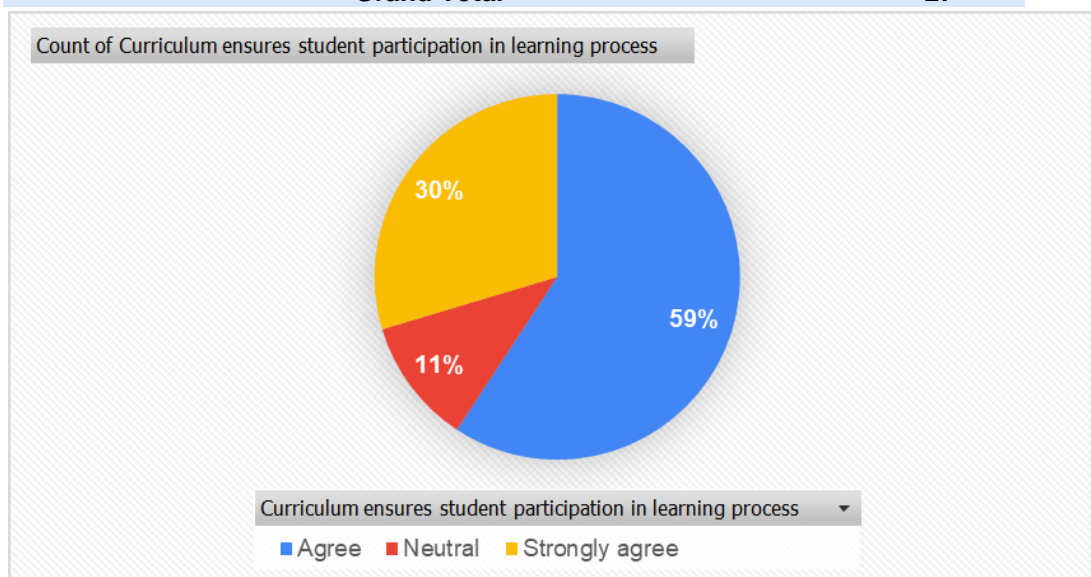

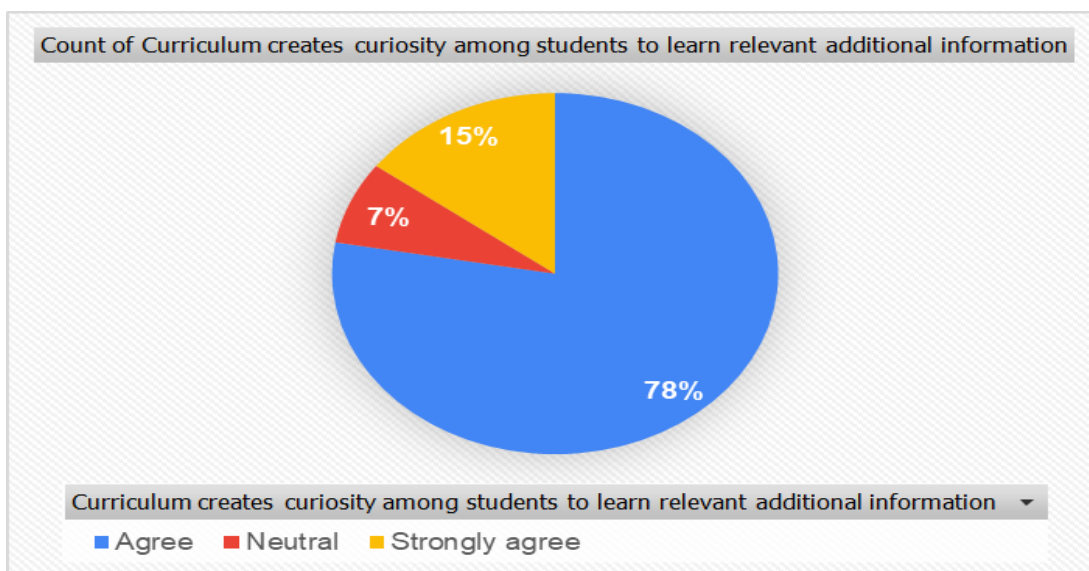

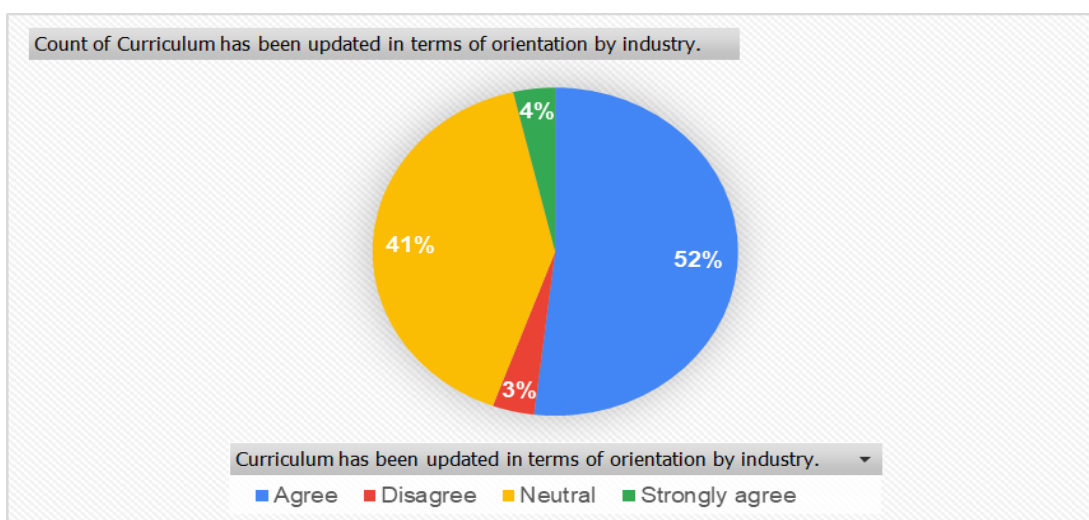

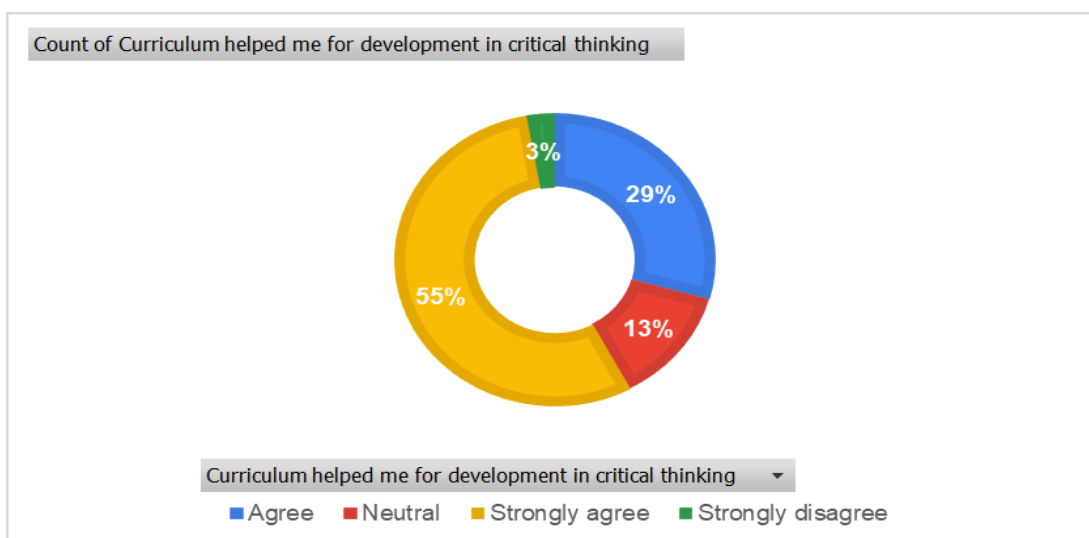

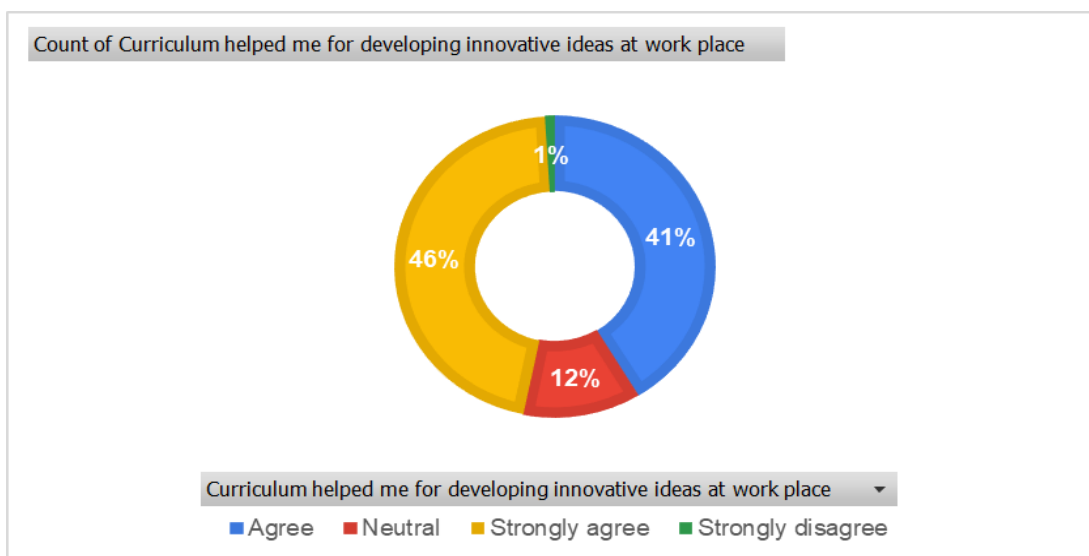
